On average, food bank clients receive only **1 gallon of milk per person per year** – far short of the recommended **3 daily servings**.

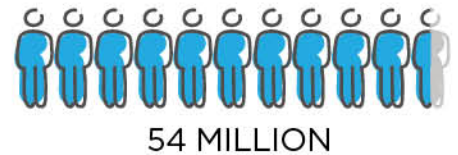
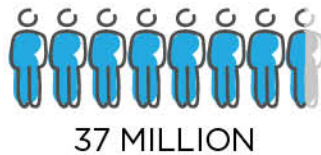
